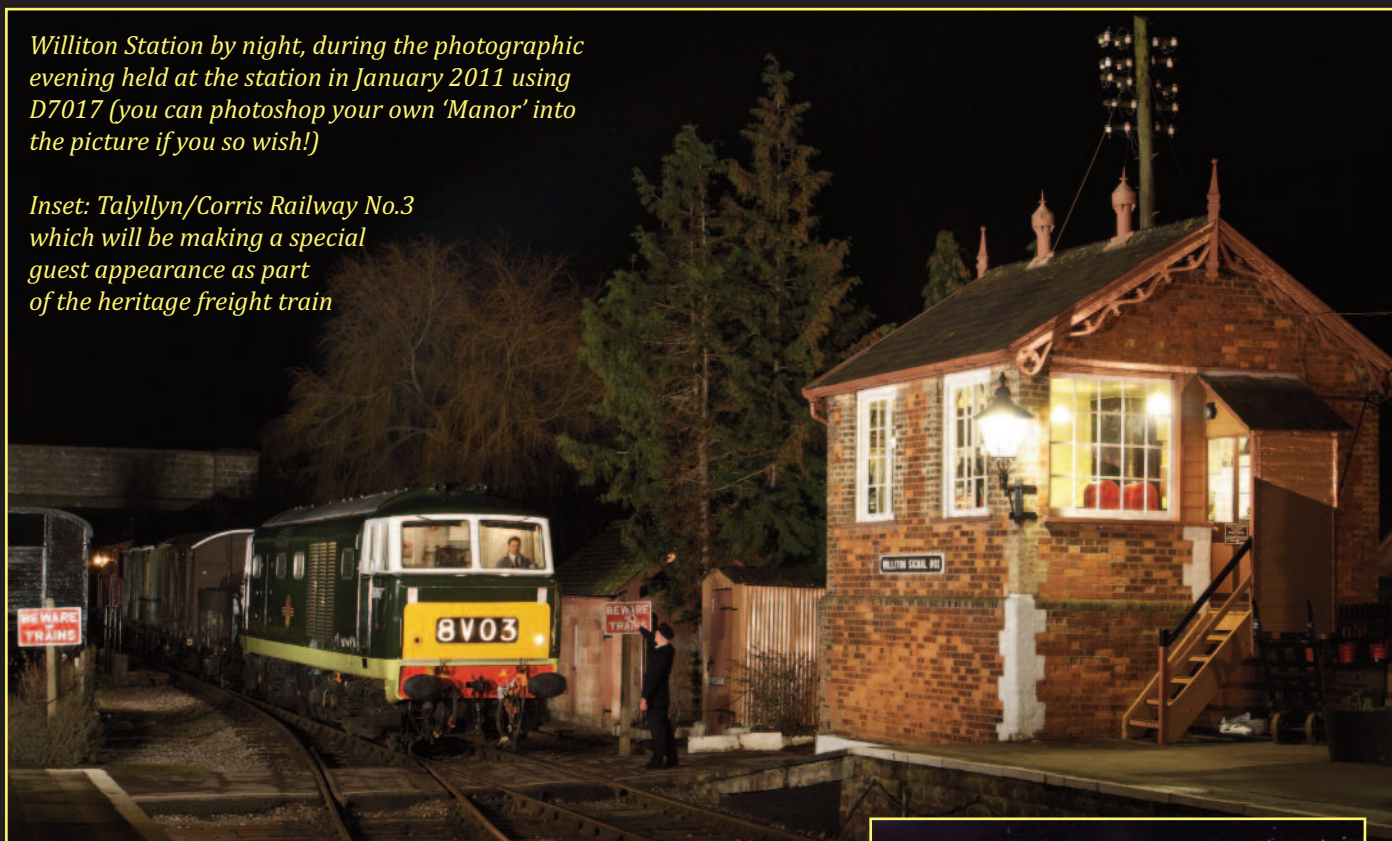


# 'Cambrian Goods' in Two Gauges West Somerset Railway, Williton Station Friday 4th October 2013

With thanks to the Special Events Planning Team of the West Somerset Railway and the Talyllyn Railway, I am pleased to be able to offer an unusual photo shoot at the Railway's Williton station on the evening of Friday 4th October 2013.

The event will feature one of the visiting 'Manor' Class locos (expected to be either 7812 or 7827) posed in and around the station. The station has the only surviving working Bristol & Exeter Railway signal box and is now resplendent with the new footbridge which blends in so well with its environs it looks as though it has always been there (albeit that it has only been completed relatively recently). As something very unusual, Talyllyn/Corris Railway No.3 will be used in the shoot on a weldrol wagon as part of the formation, giving a flavour of the days when narrow gauge locomotives used to travel to works at Oswestry and Swindon for overhaul - not something that has been recreated on a photo shoot for some time, if at all. The locomotive is visiting the line courtesy of the Talyllyn Railway and the move is being sponsored by the West Somerset Railway Association ([www.wsra.org.uk](http://www.wsra.org.uk)) The loco will be on display at Williton over the following weekend, when the works of the Diesel & Electric Preservation Group and West Somerset Restoration will be open to the public as part of the line's gala weekend.



Cost will be £30 per person made payable to *West Somerset Railway Plc* and all proceeds from the event will go to the West Somerset Railway. Spaces are limited so, if you would like to be there, please make sure you reserve a place early.
